

More on Faith

Rom.10:8-10 & 17. So then faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God. (These are important scriptures in leading someone to Christ to be saved. The Word must be preached)

Heb.11:1. Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. God is substance; unseen; but the evidence of His Faith is seen in Creation, and seen in those who hope, believe, and act on the promises of God through His Word in Jesus Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit

Heb.11:6. "But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him."

The supernatural Gift of Faith is:

The ability to confidently believe for a specific goal that God wants to be accomplished, in spite of circumstances, and appearances to the contrary. God puts faith in our hearts by the Holy Spirit.

As we respond in love and hope which fuel genuine faith we can expect God to answer us and do what we ask for. A supernatural and bold faith that steps out in a situation in which a person would otherwise fear to act. It is based on a total belief in God's Word. Like all the gifts; it is primarily given to bless others.

How does the gift of Faith work?

The Gift of Word of Knowledge informs; with a snippet of God's knowledge. Then we need the Word of Wisdom to know when, where, and how to apply the knowledge.

But; then we need the Gift of Faith exercising its power for us to deliver the Word or act on it, in its right place, and season.

We need that surge of Faith and power to also work Miracles, to heal the sick, cast out demons, speak Prophecy, etc.

With Miracles, and Healings especially; speaking the Word of Faith is essential. Our Words have power to move mountains; if we only believe, without doubt, not wavering in Faith. Mk.11:23.

There is no high-powered use of natural imagination, or psychological conditioning, no technique with the Gift of Faith. It is acting in belief that you have already received

mind, and how magnificent, and far reaching those words of supernatural faith were to be, as our universe exploded into being by the power of those explosive words.

It was an awesome Trinity moment; The Spirit Hovering over the chaos; waiting on the Word to be spoken; and the Word who became flesh and dwelt among us all there together with the Father.

Jn.Ch.1:1 “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made.”

Heb.11:3. By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.

What a privilege and responsibility we have as Christians to be able to partner with God through the power of the Holy Spirit in the name of Jesus, when we move in Faith. To do the Works of the Kingdom to heal the sick, blind, and deaf, cast out demons, cleanse lepers, raise the dead, see food multiplied, storms calmed, land blessed, etc.

James said Faith without works is dead; and show me your Faith and I will show you my Faith by my works! James Ch. 2:17-18.

For a breakthrough in Faith and Miracles, there has to be an action first. A prayer, or reaching out your hand to be lifted up from your sick bed. Jesus demanded some response in believing Faith from people in all His recorded healing miracles. For Lazarus he required it from Martha.

The epileptic boy; his father; likewise with Jairus; “Only believe!”

The Centurion spoke out amazing belief, and Faith, for his servant’s healing. The friends acted and made a hole in the roof for the paralytic.

Let Faith arise in all of you; through belief in Jesus, and the power of His Word. Pray for the sick, and see miracles of healing follow your ministry.

Ministry: Get into small groups; discuss faith, and scriptures above; read, meditate on Eph. Ch.1-2, as to who you are in Christ. Pray for each other. Expect God to answer your prayer of faith with a miracle. Amen.
